Dear Medway Council,

This email serves as a representation to Medway Council's HIF Project second round of consultation and should be recorded as such.

The dumping of up to 12,000 new homes on the Hoo Peninsula is politically motivated. Medway Council hasn't produced any reasonable alternative scenarios for comparison, especially when there are substantial numbers of available development sites in other parts of the Medway Towns.

The HIF Project and the proposed infrastructure "improvements" to enable the dumping of up to 12,000 new homes on the Hoo Peninsula is unworkable, unviable and undeliverable. The "white-elephant" railway and the "back-of-a-fag-packet" so called "relief road" are completely useless. The infrastructure on the Hoo Peninsula will overall be worse than it is today.

The destruction of the incredibly environmentally sensitive Hoo Peninsula will cause wholesale harm to nationally and internationally designated wildlife sites that make the Hoo Peninsula unique.
